


# KyPQC's Perinatal SUD Screening Diagram

**Glossary:** **SUD** - substance use disorder; **L&D** - labor & delivery; **POC**- plan of care; **NAS** - Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome; **MOUD** - medications for opioid use disorder; **HANDS** - health access nurturing development services; **LARC** - long-acting reversible contraception

Care Checklist	Clinical Team Initials/Notes/Date
L&D RN screens <b>All</b> patients using a validated SUD screening tool	
Determine if the screen is <b>Positive</b> or <b>Negative</b>	
If <b>Negative</b> , proceed to step of establish a <b>Pain Management Plan</b>	
If <b>Positive</b> , proceed with a <b>Hospital Team Huddle</b> include: maternal and infant healthcare providers, social work, charge & bedside RNs	
Follow with <b>Secondary Screenings</b> , including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Follow-up secondary SUD screening</li> <li>• Hep C, Hep B, HIV, and other recommended screening</li> <li>• Domestic violence screening</li> <li>• Mental health screening</li> </ul>	
Once secondary screening is complete, provide <b>Brief Intervention</b> : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Raise the subject in nonthreatening manner</li> <li>• Provide feedback and discuss risks</li> <li>• Enhance motivation for a health pregnancy</li> <li>• Negotiate a plan of reaching patient's goal of a health pregnancy</li> </ul>	
Next, provide additional <b>Patient Education</b> : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Discuss risk of continued substance use to mother/baby and importance of mom and family self-care</li> <li>• Discuss caring for a baby with NAS</li> <li>• Determine patient's readiness for MOUD</li> <li>• Counsel on Naloxone</li> </ul>	
After providing patient education, <b>Establish POC and Refer to Community Resources</b> : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide Naloxone Prescription</li> <li>• Refer to SUD counseling, including peer support</li> <li>• Refer to behavioral health counseling</li> <li>• Refer to MOUD counseling</li> <li>• Refer to HANDS and other community family support resources</li> <li>• Schedule follow-up appointment with healthcare provider for 1-2 weeks postpartum</li> </ul>	
<b>Establish Pain Management Plan (All Patients)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Develop a plan for managing pain during labor and postpartum</li> <li>• Follow recommended guidelines</li> </ul>	
<b>Discuss Planned Pregnancy Options</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recommend and discuss benefits of immediate postpartum LARC</li> <li>• Other options</li> </ul>	
Prior to Discharge	Clinical Team Initials/Notes/Date
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure patient receives date and time of postpartum appointment &amp; contact information of the healthcare provider's office</li> </ul>	

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
